WHAT ARE THE PREREQUISITES?

Prerequisites for the Instructor Transfer Pathway are determined by the discipline you want to teach (I.e. First Aid & CPR courses, Professional Responder courses, Wilderness & Remote First Aid courses). We also offer a simple solution for Instructors who wish to teach multiple disciplines and Instructors who wish to expand their teaching into other program areas.

Prerequisites

- 18 Years of Age
- Participant level certification in the discipline you wish to teach
- Complete a skills evaluation

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

The Red Cross Instructor Development Program (IDP) is designed to prepare candidates to support dynamic, learner-centered classroom environments. Depending on your training background, there are two pathways to become a certified Instructor outlined below. Each of the completion criteria of the IDP must be met; however candidates receive recognition for some learning components gained through previous experience. Certification is valid for three years.

Canadian Red Cross Instructor Transfer Pathway

OPTION 1: INSTRUCTOR CANDIDATES WITH PREVIOUS PROFESSIONAL RESPONDER INSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE

Option #1 is for Professional Responder (BLS, FR & EMR) Instructors of another agency. This course is designed for you to become a Red Cross Professional Responder Instructor at the level of your choosing. Must have a current non expired Instructor Certification



Candidates with a current Instructor level certification through another recognized First Aid training agency will follow the Instructor Development Pathway above, however they will not be required to complete Step 3.

OPTION 2: INSTRUCTOR CANDIDATES WITH PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE AS AN EDUCATOR OR RED CROSS WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR/TRAINER

Option #2 is for current Red Cross Instructors or Educators, who hold a participant level BLS, First Responder or Emergency Medical Responder Certification who would like to instruct these advanced levels.



Candidates with current certification as a Canadian Red Cross Water Safety Instructor/Instructor Trainer or are an educator (elementary or secondary level) will follow the Instructor Development Pathway above, however they will not be required to complete the in-class component of Step 2.
