Building upon their existing Instructional skills, Teaching Experience Supervisor candidates will develop the skills required to support Red Cross First Aid Instructor/Youth Leader candidates completing their Teaching Experience across all disciplines.

Teaching Experience Supervisor Pathway

Below is the pathway to become a certified Teaching Experience Supervisor. You must successfully complete each step before advancing to the next step.

 <p>1 Evaluate Skills and Check Prerequisites</p>	<p>Step one consists of confirming prerequisites are met: you must be a certified Instructor or Youth Leader and complete a skills evaluation.</p> <p>Skills Check must be completed by a Red Cross Instructor Trainer (IT) or a Teaching Experience Supervisor at the level you would like to instruct.</p>
 <p>2 Fundamentals Of Instruction</p>	<p>In step two you will learn the fundamentals of instruction for Teaching Experience Supervisors, which can be completed in an online format. The online course can be completed in 2–4 hours.</p>
 <p>3 Certification</p>	<p>An electronic certification will be issued upon completion. This certificate remains current as long as your Instructor certification is current.</p>

* Online learning time will vary depending on the learner.
